Grade 9 MyEd Login Instructions

- Go to https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen or google myed login
- **Login ID** your Pupil # (usually 7 digits)
- Password-- Atsss2023\$ You will be prompted to create a new password. Make sure to remember your new password! WRITE it down.
- Go to: MyInfo (top left), Requests, and choose your courses.
- Choose Courses you must toggle, no scrolling feature.
- **Post** when finished click on Post to save.
- MyEd Student Portal Open until March 1st

Grades 10, 11 & 12 MyEd Login Instructions

- **Go to** https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen_or google myed login
- **Login ID** your Pupil # (usually 7 digits)
- Password-- Enter the password you had created. You may be asked to create a new one. If you forgot your password, click on "Forgot my password".
- Go to: MyInfo (top left), Requests, and choose your courses.
- Choose Courses you must toggle, no scrolling feature.
- **Post** when finished click on Post to save.
- MyEd Student Portal Open till March 1st

Course Planning Requirements: Mandatory Classes:

Grade 9's must choose English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Careers, PE, 3 electives and two alternates. Electives must include at least 1 Fine Arts and 1 Applied Skills course.

Grade 10's must choose English, a Math, Science, Social Studies, Career Life Education, one PE 10 course, 2 electives and 2 alternates.

Grade 11's must choose English, a Social Studies, a Science, a Math, 4 electives and 2 alternates.

Grade 12's must choose English 12, Contemporary Indigenous Studies, Career Life Connections 12, 6 electives and 2 alternates.

Effective the 2024/2025 school year, all students working towards a B.C. Certificate of Graduation must successfully complete at least 4 credits in Indigenous-focused coursework.
