A few news items from your admin team for today:

Our middle school students have settled in smoothly, and our secondary students have now received their updated schedules and we can now move forward. Course changes, particularly for seniors is back on and will continue next week.

PAC lunches will move away from on-line ordering and back to first-come, first-served; please ensure your child has some snacks or alternative lunch that they can have in case food runs out, which it does on occasion. More news about PAC lunches will come.

We are excited at the progress of the building over the summer. Almost all staff have been able to move into their new classrooms and we have taken a big step toward the completion of this project. If you haven't seen the front of the school, it will look quite different.

Student parking this year is first-come, first served with no parking passes. Get to school early if you want to ensure you have a parking space in the lot. Students are asked to park only on the "high school side." Students are asked to always park in the parking lot before looking for a spot on the street.

Drop-off and pick-up is always a challenge at the beginning of the year until parents figure out the best locations to get in and out fast. A couple important expectations: vehicles can stop only along the sidewalks. If you pull into the lot and there is no room, you are asked to drive around to the back or pull out and drive back in. Please consider dropping off and picking up off campus such as on Martens St. behind the back field, down Wheel Ave., or further away from the school on Windsor St.

PE shirts are now available on schoolcashonline for purchase. Middle students have specific colours they are asked to buy (to match their house colours). Secondary students can also order new PE shirts on-line. This first order will close at the end of the month.
