Reminder to all Grads applying to the \$1250 District Scholarship Program the deadline to hand in your application to Mr. Abernethy is next Friday, Nov. 4.

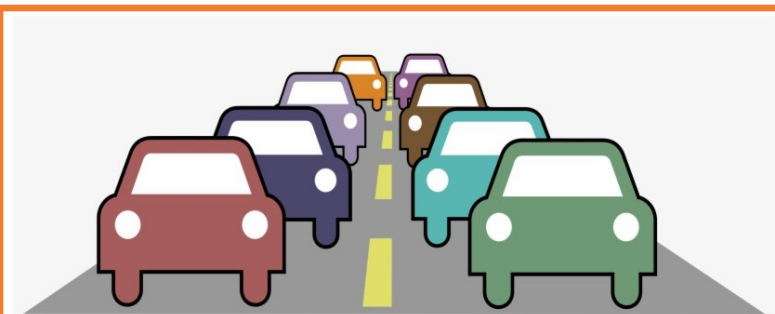
## This week in Middle:
