Restorative Action!

Did you know? Prevention is key! Restorative Action Circles engages youth in discussion about the following topics: understanding our values and how they impact our decisions and behaviour; recognizing emotions in ourselves and others and how they impact behaviour and responses; effective communications; conflict resolution; bullying prevention and skill development to effectively respond to situations of bullying and other mean behaviour. Development of these essential skills has ripple effects beyond the classroom as students take these abilities into their other circles of belonging, helping them to enjoy healthier relationships throughout their lives!

Other themes of preventative circles include: safe use of social media, diversity and inclusion, and safety in dating and non-dating relationships.

Weekly Tip #2 - "Seek first to understand then to be understood." As parents we often seek first to be understood by our children. Everyone, young or old, appreciates the feeling of being heard. The positive effects of feeling heard and understood can open up a child's ability to then really hear and learn from a parent. This one tip can positively impact communication between parents or caregivers and youth and helps to de-escalate situations of conflict.
